- Property remaining after 3 PM shall incur storage charges of \$50 per calendar day to

be deducted from Security Deposit. If not removed by 11AM on the Wednesday following the End Date, property shall also become the property of the LESSOR to be disposed of as they see fit and without compensation to the LESSEE.

- LESSEES who do not appear by 11 AM on End Day to remove their show shall forfeit the full security deposit. Property shall be removed by LESSOR to the back room and shall also become the property of the LESSOR and, if not removed by 11AM on the Wednesday following the End Date, shall be disposed of as LESSOR see fit and without compensation to the LESSEE.
